PRODUCT ACQUISITION FOR ILARIS

Once ILARIS® is ordered for a clinically appropriate patient, there are 2 options through which ILARIS can be acquired: **specialty pharmacy (SP)** and **buy and bill**.

Be sure to review the patient's coverage to determine the appropriate acquisition method for ILARIS. ILARIS is covered for patients on either the **pharmacy benefit** or **medical benefit**, with flexible acquisition methods determined by their healthcare coverage.



Specialty pharmacy

For patients covered under the **pharmacy benefit**, ILARIS is acquired through an SP.



Buy and bill

For patients covered under the **medical benefit**, ILARIS may be acquired through buy and bill **OR** commercial plans may require ILARIS to be acquired through an SP (via assignment of benefits).

FLEXIBLE ACQUISITION PROCESS FOR ILARIS

Selection may be determined by your patient's healthcare plan. Always verify benefit coverage.

Step 1: CONDUCT BENEFITS INVESTIGATION

Verify the patient's coverage type (pharmacy or medical benefit) with their healthcare plan and complete the ILARIS® Start Form and a prior authorization (PA), if required.

Step 2: ORDER ILARIS

Order ILARIS through the selected acquisition process (SP or buy and bill).

Step 3: ADMINISTER ILARIS

Review out-of-pocket (OOP) costs and co-pay with the patient. Confirm administration and treatment follow-up. Regardless of the acquisition method, work with the SP to get the co-pay applied for eligible commercially insured patients.

Step 4: SUBMIT CLAIM

Fill out a reimbursement claim form based on administration setting. Submit claim to plan.

Step 5: RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT

Track the reimbursement claim and audit claims for expedited product reimbursement.



Reimbursement for administration of ILARIS

When the SP handles product reimbursement, the physician submits a claim to the plan to get reimbursed for the administration of ILARIS only. To submit a claim to get reimbursed for ILARIS and related services, you may have to fill out either a CMS-1500 or CMS-1450 (UB-04) claim form.

- The CMS-1500 form is used when billing prescribed medications administered in physician offices
- The UB-04 form is used when billing prescribed medications administered in hospital outpatient settings

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
ONE CARD, MULTIPLE PATHWAYS

Whether co-pay claims are managed by the office or the patient, there's a variety of ways to access co-pay support for ILARIS®.

HCP-Managed Claims

If your office will manage co-pay claims, you can initiate enrollment through the Co-Pay Portal at **llaris.opushealth.com** or the Start Form. Claims can then be managed through the portal or by fax.

HCP-Managed Co-Pay Pathways




